



Dear Applicant,

As you consider participating in an educational experience in Israel, I would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to Get There! Federation's Teen & Young Adult Travel Fund and review the program guidelines.

Federation's Get There! program consists of two types of grants – Incentive Grant and Need-based. Applicants are eligible to receive **one grant only** – regardless of the type of grant:

1. Incentive Grant: An incentive for students who are:

- 13 years old through departures commencing 15 months after high school graduation. Consideration will be given to applicants through age 26.
- Participating for the first time in an approved organized peer trip or educational program to Israel or overseas.

No financial information is necessary. Eligible students may receive between \$750 and \$1,000 toward their program, pending availability of funds.

2. Need-based: For students ages 13-28 who are participating in an approved educational program in Israel and have a proven financial need. Grant amounts vary depending on the length of trip and individual need.

Please carefully review the Incentive Grant and Need-based Guidelines (see link) to determine your eligibility and understand the application process. It is important to remember completed applications must be received **no later than eight weeks** prior to trip departure.
